



NURSERY FEES from September 2018

The following is a schedule of the Nursery Fees, which are effective from September 2018.

1. For term time only contracts, fees are due for payment on or before the first day of term. For annual contracts, fees are due for payment on or before the first day of the month.
2. There is a 5% discount on fees for a second child and subsequent children attending the school or nursery at the same time (except where a child is eligible for Free Entitlement Funding).
3. A monthly surcharge of 2% will be charged for late payment.
4. 8 weeks' notice, in writing, is required for the removal of a pupil from the Nursery on an annual contract and a term's notice is required for the removal of a pupil from the Nursery on a term time contract.

* For children aged 3+ these may be subject to a reduction in respect of Free Entitlement from Wiltshire Council dependent on a child's date of birth.

A £2.50 lunch charge and a £2.50 tea charge for those children on Free Entitlement is required (or children may bring a packed lunch / tea).

Fees are inclusive of nappies, but from September 2018, milk formula must be provided by parents.

Extra hours (by exception / arrangement) £6.30/per hour.

Open 51 weeks a year (excluding Bank Holidays). Closed Christmas week for 5 days (days dependent on when Christmas falls in the year). 2018/19 closure days will be: 24, 27, 28, 31 December 2018 and 2 January 2019 (ie the Nursery will be closed from 6.00pm on Friday 21 December until 7.45am on Thursday 3 January 2019).

Little Saints Nursery currently accepts childcare vouchers from a number of providers and is signed up to the new Tax Free Childcare Scheme.

Free Entitlement

15 Hours Universal Entitlement

Every child becomes eligible for 15 hours of Universal Entitlement in the term following their 3rd birthday. This entitlement continues for 6 terms, assuming they transfer from Little Saints Nursery into St Francis School. Entitlement stops if the child transfers to a State School.

Term Time Contracts

For children on term time contracts, parents will be able to claim their universal entitlement of 15 hrs per week over St Francis School Term Time dates (34 weeks per year).

Full Time Contracts

For children on full time contracts, but who will only be claiming universal entitlement (i.e. parents are not eligible for extended entitlement) will be able to claim their universal entitlement of 15 hrs per week over St Francis School Term Time dates (34 weeks per year). The additional 17 weeks will be charged at full rate, in the month which the holiday weeks fall.

30 Hours Extended Entitlement

The additional 15 hours Extended Entitlement is now operational. This is aimed at working parents and will be means tested (by HRMC, not Little Saints Nursery). The following website provides information for parents regarding eligibility and how to apply:

After applying, and if successful, parents need to provide the Nursery Administrator with their unique code and the parent's NI number at least 6 weeks before the beginning of the term to which it applies.

Little Saints Nursery operates the 30 hours Extended Entitlement for parents on full time contracts only (i.e. contracts operating over 51 weeks). Parents will be able to claim their extended entitlement on a stretched basis of 22.4 hrs per week over 51 weeks per year.

Extended Entitlement will only be available for children in Nursery.
